- 2. Bids will be accepted until 1:00 pm on Monday, May 6, 2024. The bids will be opened at 2:00 PM on May 6, 2024, via GOOGLE. Please see NPSD website, <u>www.npenn.org/bidspec</u>, for GOOGLE meeting details a half hour prior to the bid opening.
- 3. The bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope and clearly marked on the outside, "2023-24 ViewSonic Interactive Display Equipment Bid".
- 4. Bids shall be submitted <u>on the enclosed Bid Proposal Form</u>. Bids must be typewritten or written with ink and signed by the individual, partners, or corporate officer.
- 5. The successful bidder shall bid in strict accordance with the specifications as set forth. No substitutions or alternates (other than those listed) are permitted.

Bidder shall insert the price per stated unit and the total cost extension against each item in the schedule hereto annexed, which the bidder has proposed to furnish and deliver. <u>The unit price inserted must be net and must include all delivery</u> <u>charges No Exceptions</u>. In the event of a discrepancy between the unit prices and the total cost extension, the unit price will govern. The total bid is to be the sum of the quantity times the unit price for each item.
